IOLI, Bulletin—Sept. 1975

Cover features an Eagle in Bobbin Lace

Photos: Pattern developed from Irish Crochet worked in Bobbin Lace, August convention officers & workshop, articles and photos of lace & Lacers. Featured are ten pieces of "America Picture Lace" made for the U.S. Bicentennial Celebration. Pattern and illustration of wide knitted lace.

IOLI, Bulletin—Sept. 1976

Articles: Lace study with Bicentennial theme (photo of display is not clear), Convention news and photos, Chaptr news from various states, "A Traditional Craft Lives On" an experience in Bobbin Lace starts with saving three lace pillows from destruction, Handweavers convention, Lacemaking in Russia. Motifs and edgings directions for Tatters, samples are included. Illustration and pattern of Saxony Bobbin Lace.

IOLI, Bulletin—Sept 1978

Convention news, a letter from Lia Baumeister-Jonker shared by Kaethe Kliot.

Articles: Old laces with photos, Lacemaking in Brussels, Bobbins for lacemaking, "Lace – a super subject for a stamp", a response fro Belgium regarding reports from K. Kliot (May '78) & Dr. Bultinck (Jan '78) concerning lace sources in Belgium. "Linen Lace Thread?" - information on threads and lacemaking. "Needle lace with Nancy" - keep bars (bridges) from twisting. Tatting motifs & edgings directions and samples shown.

IOLI, Bulletin – Jan. 1983

Article from the Ada Herald, Ohio: "Bobbin Lace Maker in Community", Photos: Tape lace collar wins 4th place, Sampler Exhibition – Dresden Plate in Bobbin Lace wins 1st place & Needle lace sampler get honorable mention. Articles: "Antique Lace Collecting is Delicate Business, Tatting Shuttles. Photos of lace cards from the Rijksmuseum, Netherlands. Patern of child's collar in Bobbin Lace, a small mat pattern – either Swiss or Austrian. "Arlene McKinnels Bucks Lesson" – Hearts with cucumber foot edging. Patterns and instructions.

IOLI, Bulletin – Vol. VI No. 3 – Jan-Feb 1986

Article: "Cover Story" Cover features Point d'Angleterre a late 17th or early 18th century Flemish Bobbin Lace. "Lets Make Needle Lace", Australian Lace Stamp, Heart Pillows & Patterns, Bobbin Lace Yoke with Spiders, Directions for mounting lace on fabric, "A Nest of Spiders" – 5 illustrations of spider clusters. Inside back cover "Cross-Twist-Crossword".

NOTE: A comparison of these old Bulletins will show a marked improvement of publishing techniques over the years.

IOLI, Bulletin – Vol 29 No. 4 – Summer 2009

Cover features a sample of Bedfordshire edging. "Competition Lace Butterfly", no limitations for design.
